

## **Student Climate Survey**

Student safety and well-being is our highest priority. As part of our on-going efforts to make our school environment positive and respectful for everyone, we participated in a Board-wide student survey in spring 2011. Students in Grades 4-12 at all schools throughout the KPR Board completed the anonymous survey electronically, at school. Since the survey was anonymous and confidential, it did not identify individual students. It was designed to show us how safe, welcome and included all students feel in their own school.

Each school in KPR has now received the overall survey results for its students. We will be working closely with staff and our school council to review the results. Our goal is to find out how our students feel about issues such as bullying, harassment and inclusion, and whether they feel we are supporting them in their learning. The next steps will be to identify specific areas of concern. This will allow us to take concrete steps together to ensure our school is safe, respectful, inclusive and caring for ALL students.

By working together, we can take steps towards ensuring everyone in our school feels respected, accepted and included.
